

How to pull out vertical optical cables

Article Overview

Always pull optical cables by their internal strength members, not the outer jacket, to prevent damage and maintain performance.

Safety and Preparation

Before removing any optical cable, turn off all connected devices to prevent signal disruption or electrical hazards . Wear protective gloves and safety glasses to protect both yourself and the delicate fiber . Identify the exact cable you need to remove to avoid disconnecting the wrong line .

Removing Home or Consumer Optical Cables

For digital optical cables used in TVs, soundbars, or home audio systems:

- o Locate the port and stabilize the device to prevent movement .
- o Grip the connector head, not the cable itself, and gently pull straight out .
- o If the connector has clips or locks, squeeze the sides while pulling to release it .
- o Cover both ends with protective caps to prevent dust accumulation .
- o Avoid bending or twisting the cable, and do not pull on the cable jacket .

Removing Professional Fiber Optic Cables

For vertical fiber optic installations in telecom or networking:

- o Expose the strength member (usually Kevlar or aramid yarn) by carefully stripping a small portion of the outer jacket .
- o Loop the strength member through a pull-eye or secure it with tape/knots to ensure a firm grip .
- o Pull the cable slowly and evenly, avoiding sharp bends or twists. Never pull by the outer jacket alone, as this can stretch or damage the fiber .
- o Use specialized pulling tools like the Cleerline SSF-PULLEYED for pre-terminated cables to reduce twisting and friction .
- o Release any tension in the conduit or pathway before pulling to prevent snagging or kinking .

Additional Tips

- o Do not force the cable; if it resists, check for clips, bends, or obstructions.
- o Maintain a minimum bend radius to prevent microbends that can degrade signal quality.
- o Store removed cables properly, coiling them loosely and keeping connectors capped. By following these steps, you can safely remove vertical optical cables while preserving both the cable integrity and the connected equipment .
