

How to remove optical fiber from an optical cable

Clean the Fiber Use lint-free wipes soaked in isopropyl alcohol to clean the exposed fiber. This removes dust, debris, or residue that could affect signal quality or splicing . 6. Cleave the Fiber (Optional for Termination) If you plan to terminate or splice the fiber, use a fiber cleaver to create a clean, perpendicular end face. Proper cleaving ensures minimal light loss and optimal signal transmission . Safety Tips
