To insert a plug-in optical splitter, remove protective caps, clean connectors, and carefully slide the splitter into the designated slot or adapter frame, ensuring proper fiber routing and minimal bending.

Step-by-Step Installation

1. Prepare the Installation Area

- o Identify the slot or compartment in the fiber distribution box or cabinet where the plug-in splitter will be installed .

- o Ensure fibers are routed neatly and secured to prevent stress or accidental disconnection.

- o Tighten any thumb screws or locking mechanisms to secure the splitter in place .

- o Perform optical testing using an OTDR or power meter to verify signal integrity and correct splitting ratios .

- o For outdoor fiber distribution boxes, use a dedicated splitter box with proper environmental protection. Ensure the box allows for flexible installation methods such as pole, wall, or side mounting .
