Fiber transmits data using light signals through glass strands, delivering faster speeds and lower latency than cable or DSL connections that rely on. Fiber termination box (FTB), also known as optical terminal box (OTB), generally refers to a distribution box specially designed for fiber cable management (fiber patch cables/pigtails) in FTTH applications. It offers a cost-effective method to handle large quantities of fiber cables in an orderly. OFNL operates an 'Open Access' fibre optic network to new build residential and commercial developments across the UK.
