

How to wire a right-angle welding machine in a distribution box

To wire a right-angle welding machine in a distribution box, connect the machine to the appropriate phase lines with proper grounding and overload protection, following safety and manufacturer guidelines.

Step 1: Prepare the Distribution Box

Ensure the distribution box is equipped with an overload protection device (circuit breaker or knife switch) and a grounding terminal. For a 220V welding machine, use one phase line, one neutral line, and one ground wire. For a 380V two-phase welding machine, connect two phase lines plus a grounding wire, and include the neutral if local control is required ().

Step 2: Select and Prepare the Power Cable

Use a 2-3 meter connecting wire rated for the welding machine's voltage and current. Ensure the cable is insulated and free from damage. The cable should have clearly marked conductors for phase, neutral, and ground ().

Step 3: Connect the Welding Machine
