

How to wire a two-box electrical distribution box for home use

Article Overview

Wiring a household distribution box involves connecting the main supply to MCBs and RCDs, ensuring proper neutral and earth connections, and organizing circuits safely according to load and color codes.

Preparation and Safety

Before starting, turn off the main power supply to prevent electrical hazards. Use insulated tools, gloves, and safety gear. Ensure the distribution box is properly installed in a dry, accessible location at an appropriate height (~1.5m) with good ventilation. Gather all necessary materials: MCBs, RCCBs, busbars, wires, wire strippers, screwdrivers, and cable ties.

Components Overview

- o Main MCB (Double Pole): Controls the incoming phase and neutral; typically 63A for domestic use.
- o Single-Pole MCBs: Protect individual branch circuits like lighting and sockets.
- o RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Provides protection against earth leakage.
- o Busbars: Distribute neutral and earth connections to all circuits.

Wiring Steps

- o Incoming Supply Connection: Connect the phase and neutral from the main supply to the input terminals of the main MCB.
- o MCB Arrangement: Arrange branch MCBs from left to right; reserve space on the right for future expansion.
- o Branch Circuit Wiring: Connect each MCB to its respective load circuit. Use 2.5mm² wires for lighting and sockets, and 4mm² for high-power appliances like air conditioners.
- o Neutral and Earth Connections: Connect all neutral wires to the neutral busbar and all earth wires to the earth busbar. Ensure RCCB is correctly wired between the main MCB and branch circuits.
- o Wire Color Coding: Use blue for neutral, yellow/green/red for phases (A/B/C), and green/yellow for earth.
- o Cable Management: Route wires neatly; bind with plastic ties at uniform spacing to prevent tangling and maintain clear paths.
- o Labeling: Clearly mark each circuit for easy identification and future maintenance.

Final Checks

- o Perform a visual inspection to ensure no exposed wires or loose connections.
- o Use a multimeter to verify continuity and correct voltage before switching on the main supply.
- o Ensure all protective devices (MCBs, RCCBs) are functioning properly. Following these steps ensures a
