Standard Single-Gang and Junction Boxes

For typical wall outlets and light switches, single-gang boxes are commonly used. Junction boxes for splicing multiple wires are often slightly larger, commonly around 4 inches wide by 4 inches tall, with similar depth options . These dimensions ensure compliance with NEC wire-fill guidelines and provide enough space for safe installation.

Residential Breaker Panels

Residential breaker panels or distribution boxes, which divide incoming power into multiple circuits, are significantly wider. Standard widths for these panels typically range from 12 to 18 inches, depending on the number of circuits and manufacturer specifications . Heights vary from about 24 to 36 inches, and depths are usually 4 to 6 inches, providing sufficient space for bus bars, circuit breakers, and wiring . Double meter panels or larger multi-family units may be wider to accommodate additional circuits.
