Therefore, if Huijue uses Huawei network equipment, only certified Huawei optical modules should be deployed to ensure stability and performance.

Deployment Considerations

Huawei optical modules are hot-swappable and support monitoring of voltage, temperature, bias current, and optical power, which is critical for maintaining network reliability . The choice of module depends on the required transmission rate, fiber type, and connector interface. For example, QSFP28 modules are suitable for 100G Ethernet, while SFP+ modules are used for 10G connections . Huawei's vertical integration of optical chips and modules ensures high performance, low insertion loss, and energy efficiency .
