Optical Network Terminal (ONT): The ONT is installed by your ISP and connects directly to the fiber optic line entering your home or business. It converts the light pulses from the fiber into electrical signals that your router can use. The ONT typically requires a power source and includes LED indicators for power, connection status, and data activity . **Fiber-Ready Router:** After the ONT, a fiber-ready router is needed to distribute the internet connection. This router connects to the ONT via an Ethernet cable, usually through the WAN port. Modern routers support high-speed fiber plans and may include WiFi 6 or WiFi 7 technology, multiple gigabit Ethernet ports, and advanced features like LAN aggregation for faster wired connections . **Ethernet Cables:** High-quality Ethernet cables (Cat5e or Cat6) are used to connect the ONT to the router and devices. These cables ensure that the high speeds of fiber internet are maintained without bottlenecks .

Setup Process

- o **Install the ONT:** Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize.
- o **Connect the Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port. Power on the router and confirm connectivity through indicator lights.
- o **Distribute Internet:** The router broadcasts WiFi throughout your home or provides wired connections to devices. For larger homes, mesh WiFi systems or extenders can improve coverage and eliminate dead zones .

- o **Router Compatibility:** Ensure the router supports your fiber plan's maximum speed to avoid bottlenecks. Third-party routers may offer more customization but require proper configuration.
- o **Home Size and Device Load:** Larger homes or many connected devices may benefit from mesh networks or routers with advanced WiFi standards.
- o **Maintenance:** The ONT is usually owned and maintained by the ISP, while the router can be either ISP-provided or purchased independently .
