- o Conduct electrical tests such as continuity, insulation resistance, and functional testing of switches and circuits before energizing the system .

- o Follow total quality management principles, ensuring zero-defect installation and adherence to safety standards .

- o Coordinate with other contractors, such as air-conditioning or architectural teams, to finalize fixture locations and avoid conflicts .

- o Use galvanized or enameled steel hardware for durability and compliance with technical standards .
