Galvanized cable trays should be installed with careful planning, proper support spacing, precise alignment, and secure grounding to ensure durability and safety.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations in the building or plant area. Inspect all materials upon delivery to ensure they match the approved submittals and are free from damage or coating defects. Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of about one meter, protecting them from moisture and direct sunlight to prevent corrosion or coating damage .

Material Handling

Handle galvanized trays carefully to avoid scratches or dents that could compromise the zinc coating. For long runs, use cable tray rollers to lay trays smoothly and prevent kinks or bending . Ensure all fittings, connectors, and accessories are compatible with the tray system.

Mounting and Support

- o Use appropriate brackets, clamps, or hangers for wall, ceiling, or floor mounting.
- o Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load capacity .
- o Align trays straight and level, connecting sections securely with the provided fittings.
- o Avoid using trays as walkways or ladders, as they are designed solely for cable support .

Cable Laying

- o Lay cables neatly within the tray, separating by voltage or function.
- o Use cable ties or straps to maintain organization and prevent movement.
- o Leave sufficient slack for thermal expansion, vibration, or future adjustments .

Grounding and Bonding

- o Metal trays, including galvanized steel, must be properly grounded to maintain electrical safety.
- o Use bonding jumpers across tray sections to ensure continuity and prevent potential differences .
- o Inspect connections to ensure the zinc coating is not excessively damaged at bonding points, as minor scratches are protected by the sacrificial zinc layer .

Final Checks and Documentation

- o Verify alignment, support spacing, and secure connections.
- o Label cables and document the installation for future maintenance and troubleshooting.
- o Ensure compliance with relevant standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable trays and BS 6946 for channel support systems . By following these steps, galvanized cable trays will provide a durable, corrosion-resistant, and safe support system for electrical and communication cables in industrial or commercial installations.
