IP ratings of IP41 to IP66 are recommended depending on indoor or outdoor installation, providing protection against dust, water, and debris (). 3. Types of Distribution Boxes

- o Main Distribution Board (MDB): Handles incoming power for the entire building, typically installed in dedicated electrical rooms ().
- o Sub-Main Distribution Board (SMDB): Distributes power to specific floors or zones.
- o Final Distribution Board (FDB): Protects individual circuits for lighting, outlets, and small appliances ().

Installation Practices

- o Mounting: Use ready-to-install brackets to secure the DB to walls or panels, ensuring stability and alignment ().
 - o Wiring: Maintain proper separation of incoming and outgoing circuits, and ensure busbars and protective devices (MCBs, RCCBs, RCBOs) are correctly installed.
 - o Accessibility: Ensure doors are reversible and removable gland plates are used for easy maintenance ().
 - o Thermal Considerations: Install in ventilated areas or provide heat dissipation to prevent overheating in high ambient temperatures ().

- o Include a main isolator switch for emergency de-energization ().
 - o Ensure encapsulated busbar systems to prevent accidental contact ().
 - o Verify that all components are type-tested and certified for the intended load and environmental conditions ().
