

Installing a T-junction inside the cable tray

Article Overview

A T-junction in a cable tray allows a branch run to split from the main tray, and proper installation requires precise cutting, fitting, support, and grounding to maintain safety and compliance.

Planning and Preparation

Before installing a T-junction, plan the route of both the main and branch trays, considering clearance, load capacity, and cable separation requirements . Select the appropriate tray type--ladder, ventilated, or solid-bottom--based on airflow, load, and environmental conditions . Ensure the tray width and depth can accommodate the total number of cables, including the branch run.

Cutting and Fitting

To create a T-junction:

- o Mark the main tray where the branch will connect.
- o Cut the tray carefully using appropriate tools to avoid damaging the tray or coating .
- o Install a T-piece fitting or fabricate a branch using compatible tray accessories. Ventilated or solid-bottom T-pieces are available depending on the application .
- o Ensure the branch tray aligns properly with the main tray and maintains the correct bend radius for cables exiting the junction .

Securing and Supporting

- o Use approved connectors, clamps, and brackets to secure both the main and branch trays .
- o Maintain proper support spacing, typically 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load .
- o Apply expansion fittings if the installation is subject to thermal expansion or long runs .

Cable Management

- o Lay cables neatly, separating by voltage and function, and leave slack for future adjustments .
- o Maintain minimum bend radius at the junction to prevent cable damage .
- o Use cable ties or straps to organize cables within the T-junction.

Grounding and Bonding

- o Ensure metal trays are properly grounded using bonding jumpers across the junction to maintain electrical

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continuity .

- o Check that all cut ends are painted or treated to prevent corrosion and maintain safety .

Final Checks

- o Verify alignment, level, and secure connections.

- o Confirm that the T-junction does not obstruct airflow or violate spacing requirements.

- o Inspect for any sharp edges or damage that could compromise cable insulation. By following these steps, a T-junction can be safely and efficiently integrated into a cable tray system, ensuring compliance with electrical standards and long-term reliability .
