

# Is a power cabinet an electrical distribution box

Distribution boxes are installed at the end of the power distribution system, such as in homes, offices, or specific areas of a building . **Relationship:** In a typical power system, electricity flows from the transformer to the main distribution cabinet, then to regional cabinets, floor distribution boxes, and finally to the user's indoor distribution box and electrical equipment. The cabinet acts as a "middle manager," while the distribution box serves as the terminal connection point . In summary, while both are part of the electrical distribution system, a power cabinet is a centralized, high-capacity distribution unit, and a distribution box is a smaller, terminal unit for delivering electricity to end-use devices.
