- o **Network Congestion:** Multiple devices streaming, gaming, or downloading large files at the same time can overload your router. Some routers struggle to manage high traffic, causing slowdowns .
- o **Device Limitations:** Older computers, smartphones, or tablets may have network cards that cannot fully utilize high-speed fiber. Ensuring your devices support gigabit Ethernet or modern Wi-Fi standards is essential .
- o **Wi-Fi Interference:** Nearby networks, Bluetooth devices, and microwaves can interfere with your Wi-Fi signal, reducing effective speeds .

Steps to Fix Slow Speeds

- o **Restart Your Router:** Power cycling your router can clear temporary glitches and restore speed. Unplug it for 60 seconds, then plug it back in .
- o **Check Cables and Connections:** Ensure Ethernet cables are Cat 6 or higher and properly connected. Damaged or loose cables can reduce speed .
- o **Run a Speed Test:** Connect a device directly via Ethernet and test your internet speed. Compare results with your plan to determine if the router is the bottleneck .
- o **Update Router Firmware:** Manufacturers often release updates that improve performance and fix bugs. Check your router's settings for firmware updates .
- o **Optimize Wi-Fi Settings:** Change channels to avoid interference, use 5 GHz bands for faster speeds, and consider Wi-Fi extenders or mesh systems for larger homes .
- o **Limit Device Load:** Use Quality of Service (QoS) settings to prioritize critical applications and reduce congestion from multiple devices .
- o **Upgrade Your Router:** If your router is old or cannot handle gigabit speeds, consider a modern Wi-Fi 6 router capable of supporting multiple devices at high speeds . By systematically checking these factors, you can identify whether your router is causing slow fiber internet and take steps to restore optimal performance.
