The CIF (Cost, Insurance, and Freight) price includes the base battery cost, international shipping, and insurance. For Latvian exports to Europe or nearby regions:

- o Shipping and insurance typically add 5-15% to the base price.
- o Certification premiums (e.g., UL or CE) can increase costs by 8-12% .
- o Tariffs are generally low within the EU, but exports to non-EU countries may face additional duties. For example, U.S. import tariffs on lithium-ion batteries can exceed 10-28% depending on classification and Section 301 measures .

Technology Impact

- o Lithium-ion (LiFePO₄, NMC, LFP): Dominates Latvian exports, offering high efficiency and long lifespan. CIF prices for low-temperature resistant variants are at the higher end of the EUR450-EUR1,300/kWh range .
- o Sodium-ion or hybrid chemistries: Emerging alternatives may offer slightly lower costs but are less common in Latvian exports .

Market Trends

- o The European Union expects battery pack prices to fall below \$100/kWh by 2026/27, but specialized low-temperature resistant systems remain above this due to additional engineering and materials .
- o Global energy storage exports fluctuate between \$180-\$320/kWh, reflecting chemistry, scale, and regional policies .
