

Length of cable tray hangers

Article Overview

Cable tray hangers should generally be spaced between 1.5 meters (5 feet) and 3 meters (10 feet), depending on tray type, cable load, and installation conditions.

Standard Guidelines

For horizontal cable tray runs, the National Electrical Code (NEC) recommends that supports should not exceed 5 feet (1.5 meters) apart to safely support the weight of cables and any additional loads such as wind or seismic forces, with an ideal range of 4 to 6 feet (1.2 to 1.8 meters) for uniform load distribution . For industrial or heavy-duty installations, typical hanger spacing is 1.5 to 2 meters, with closer spacing (around 1.5 meters) recommended for heavier cables or metallic trays to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity . Lighter cables, such as data or signal lines, may allow spacing up to 3 meters .

Key Considerations

- o Tray Type and Material: Ladder-type trays or perforated trays may require closer support spacing due to their structural characteristics .
- o Cable Load: Heavier cables or bundles require shorter hanger intervals to avoid excessive deflection.
- o Environmental Factors: Outdoor or corrosive environments may necessitate hangers with protective finishes (e.g., hot-dip galvanized) and closer spacing to maintain stability .
- o Vertical Runs: Supports should be fixed to the building structure at intervals preferably less than 2 meters .
- o Corners and Bends: Install one hanger on each side of bends or T-junctions to maintain stability and prevent stress on cables .

Practical Tips

- o Always consult the manufacturer's specifications for maximum allowable span, as tray design and material can affect support requirements .
- o Include a safety margin of 25% for future cable additions or unexpected loads .
- o Ensure hangers are compatible with the tray material to prevent galvanic corrosion, especially in wet or coastal environments . By following these guidelines, cable trays will remain level, secure, and compliant with safety standards, reducing the risk of sagging, mechanical strain, or premature failure.

The length between support positions will change depending on the cable design, size, materials and weight. For example, an MDPE
