



Municipal Optical Cable Conduit Dimensions

Preview

Optical cable is usually placed in a 25 to 40 mm inside diameter (ID) sub-duct which is placed into an existing larger diameter communications conduit. Most communications conduits can be fitted with three or four sub-ducts. Sub-ducts are often referred to as innerducts. CAUTION: Care must be taken to avoid cable damage during handling and placing. Any such damage may alter the cable's characteristics to the extent that the cable section may have to be replaced. To ensure all.
