

Article Overview

Distribution boxes are standardized with specific dimensions, mounting heights, and spacing to ensure safety, accessibility, and compliance with national electrical standards.

Standard Installation Heights

- o Fixed distribution boxes: The vertical distance from the bottom of the box to the ground should be 1.3m to 1.5m.
- o Mobile distribution boxes: The bottom should be 0.6m to 1.5m above the ground .

Spacing Requirements

- o Distance between a distribution box and a switch box should not exceed 30 meters.
- o Horizontal distance between a switch box and fixed electrical equipment should not exceed 3 meters .
- o Each piece of electrical equipment must have a dedicated switch box, following the "one equipment, one switch, one RCD" rule .

Mechanical and Material Specifications

- o Enclosures are generally made of steel plates; insulating plates are acceptable, but wood is not recommended .
- o Steel thickness:
 - o Distribution box enclosure: $\geq 1.5\text{mm}$
 - o Power distribution cabinet body: $\geq 2.0\text{mm}$
 - o Doors and panels: $\geq 2.0\text{mm}$
 - o Back panels: $\geq 3.0\text{mm}$
- o Mounting lugs: Two lugs (40x4 mm flat steel, 10 cm length) welded at bottom left and top right for non-floor-standing boxes .

Standard Dimensions

Distribution boxes vary by type and number of ways (1-way to 36-ways). Typical dimensions include:

- o Small boxes: 100-150 mm width, 100-150 mm height, 60-80 mm depth
- o Medium boxes: 200-300 mm width, 200-300 mm height, 100-150 mm depth
- o Large/industrial boxes: 400-600 mm width, 400-600 mm height, 150-300 mm depth .



National Standard Dimensions of Distribution Boxes

Internal Layout and Wiring

- o Reserved openings for incoming and outgoing wires must comply with Class 3 sealing requirements after assembly .
- o Guide rails and internal component positions must allow safe and organized wiring.
- o Box fill calculations should follow conductor size and quantity standards to prevent overcrowding and ensure safety .
