Local Suppliers and Services

Nicaragua has domestic companies specializing in optical fiber cables and related services. Telenicsa is a prominent Nicaraguan company providing fiber optic cabling, network design, civil works, installation of aerial and canalized networks, and maintenance of fiber optic backbones. They supply both single-mode and multi-mode fiber, routing equipment, and tower construction services, catering to major local enterprises and telecommunications projects in Managua and other regions .

Imports and Trade

Despite local production, Nicaragua imports a significant portion of its optical fiber cables. In 2024, the country imported approximately 797,155 kg of optical fiber cables, valued at \$7.2 million. Major suppliers include China (\$3.7M), Mexico (\$2.8M), the United States (\$162K), India (\$156K), and El Salvador (\$98K) . This indicates a reliance on international sources for high-quality or specialized optical cables.

Market Characteristics

The telecommunications sector in Nicaragua is fully privatized and considered one of the most modern in Central America. Optical fiber cables are sold at relatively high prices due to the inclusion of product cost, international shipping, import duties, customs clearance, and local delivery charges . The market serves multiple applications, including telecommunications, IT and data centers, networking, broadcast, and power utilities.
