

No fiber optic interface on the router

Using an Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

Most fiber internet services require an ONT, which acts as a bridge between the fiber line and your router. The ONT converts the optical signal into a standard Ethernet connection that your router can use. To set this up:

Using a Media Converter

If an ONT is not provided or you want to connect directly to a fiber line, a media converter can be used. This device converts the fiber optic signal to Ethernet, allowing any standard router to connect. Key points:

- o Ensure the media converter supports the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and connector type (SC/APC, SC/UPC).
- o Connect the fiber cable to the media converter and then use an Ethernet cable to connect the converter to your router's WAN port.
- o Power on both devices and verify connectivity .

- o Check compatibility: Only use transceivers or SFP modules compatible with your router or switch to avoid unpredictable behavior .
- o Inspect cables and connectors: Fiber is sensitive; avoid sharp bends, contamination, or damage. Clean connectors with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol if needed .
- o Verify ISP activation: Ensure your fiber service is active and the ONT is properly registered with your ISP .
- o Monitor indicator lights: A "LOS" (Loss of Signal) LED or inactive link lights indicate connectivity issues .
