Price Range and Factors

The cost of a photovoltaic DC combiner box varies widely based on its design and functionality. Basic models with 4-6 input strings, standard overcurrent protection, and IP65-rated enclosures can start around \$50-\$100 per unit. More advanced models with 8-24 string inputs, integrated Type 2 DC surge protection devices (SPD), monitoring for voltage, current, and temperature, and higher voltage ratings (up to 1500V DC) can cost \$200-\$500 or more . Key factors influencing cost include:

- o Number of input strings: More strings require larger busbars and additional fuses, increasing price .
- o Voltage rating: Standard boxes are rated 600-1000V DC, while high-voltage boxes (up to 1500V DC) are more expensive .
- o Protection features: Inclusion of DC fuses, DC isolator switches, and surge protection devices adds to cost .
- o Monitoring capabilities: Boxes with string-level monitoring for current, voltage, and temperature are higher-end and improve system performance and ROI .
- o Enclosure quality: IP65 or higher-rated weatherproof enclosures suitable for outdoor installation increase durability and cost .

Practical Considerations

Using a combiner box reduces wiring complexity by consolidating multiple PV strings into a single output to the inverter, which can save on labor and material costs in large installations . For small systems with 1-2 strings, a combiner box may not be necessary, as modern inverters often have built-in MPPT inputs . In summary, for a typical commercial or residential PV system, expect to pay between \$50 and \$500 per DC combiner box, with the final price depending on the number of strings, voltage rating, protection features, and monitoring capabilities .
