



PoE switch malfunction caused by unplugging and replugging the network cable

Article Overview

Unplugging and replugging a network cable can cause a PoE switch to temporarily stop supplying power due to port error states, power negotiation issues, or PoE budget constraints.

Why This Happens

When a PoE-enabled device (PD) is disconnected and reconnected, the switch (PSE) must re-detect the device and renegotiate power delivery. During this process, several issues can occur:

- o Port Error or Shutdown: Some switches automatically disable a port if a fault is detected during reconnection, showing the device as connected but unpowered ().
- o PoE Budget Exceeded: If the total power demand of all connected devices exceeds the switch's PoE budget, the switch may disable power on lower-priority ports to maintain service for higher-priority devices ().
- o Cable or Mode Mismatch: Using a damaged cable or one that does not meet PoE standards can prevent proper power delivery. Additionally, mismatched PoE modes (Alternative A/B or 4-pair delivery) between the switch and PD can cause failures ().
- o Firmware or Configuration Issues: Outdated firmware or misconfigured switch settings can interfere with automatic power negotiation ().

Steps to Resolve the Issue

- o Check Port Status: Use switch commands (e.g., show power inline on Cisco) to verify if the port is administratively down, error-disabled, or still connected but unpowered ().
- o Reset the Port: Disable and re-enable the port or perform a switch reboot to re-initiate PoE negotiation ().
- o Inspect the Cable: Ensure the Ethernet cable is Cat5e or higher, undamaged, and supports PoE ().
- o Verify PoE Budget: Confirm that the total power draw of all PDs does not exceed the switch's PoE budget. Adjust priorities if necessary ().
- o Check PoE Mode Compatibility: Ensure the PD and switch support compatible PoE modes (Alternative A/B or 4-pair) ().
- o Update Firmware: Apply the latest firmware to the switch to fix known PoE negotiation bugs ().

Preventive Measures

- o Plan for Headroom: Keep 20-30% of the PoE budget free to accommodate reconnections or new devices ().
- o Use Quality Cables: Always use certified PoE-capable cables to reduce connection errors.
- o Monitor Ports: Enable SNMP or logging to detect intermittent PoE issues early ().
- o Prioritize Critical Devices: Assign higher PoE priority to essential devices to prevent power loss during



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budget constraints ().

By following these steps, you can restore power to the affected device and minimize the risk of PoE malfunctions caused by unplugging and replugging network cables.
