

Article Overview

Fiber optic cable weight and price vary by type, core count, and construction, with single-mode cables generally lighter and less expensive per foot than multimode or armored variants.

Typical Fiber Optic Cable Weights

- o 1-core 900um tight-buffered fiber: 0.9 kg/km, outer diameter 0.9 mm, suitable for pigtails and patch panels, with a minimum bend radius of 30 mm during installation (temperature range -20°C to +70°C) .
- o Multicore indoor/outdoor cables: Weight increases with strand count and jacket type. For example, a 12-strand multimode cable may weigh 5-10 kg/km, while armored or direct-burial cables can exceed 20 kg/km depending on protective layers and materials .
- o Armored or plenum-rated cables: Additional layers for mechanical protection or fire safety increase weight significantly, often 2-3 times heavier than standard indoor cables .

Price Ranges

- o Single-mode fiber (OS1/OS2): \$0.10-\$0.50 per foot for the cable itself; bulk purchases reduce costs by 20-40% .

Factors Affecting Weight and Price

- o Fiber Type: Single-mode fibers are lighter and cheaper per foot than multimode fibers due to smaller core diameters and simpler transceivers .

- o Jacket Material: LSZH, plenum, or armored jackets add weight and cost.
- o Installation Environment: Outdoor, direct-burial, or aerial-rated cables are heavier and more expensive than indoor riser-rated cables .
- o Pre-terminated Assemblies: Factory-terminated cables with connectors cost more than raw cable spools .

For planning purposes, lightweight 1-core tight-buffered cables weigh around 0.9 kg/km and cost \$0.10-\$0.50
