Structure of Fiber Optic Patch Cords

Fiber optic patch cords consist of several key components:

- o Core and Cladding: The core carries the light signal, typically 9um for single-mode (OS2) and 50-62.5um for multimode (OM1-OM5) fibers, surrounded by cladding that reflects light back into the core for efficient transmission .
- o Buffer Coating: Protects the fiber from physical damage and moisture.
- o Strength Members: Materials like aramid yarn or steel provide tensile strength and prevent breakage.
- o Outer Jacket: Protects the cable from environmental factors. Common types include PVC (flexible, indoor use), LSZH (low smoke, zero halogen, safe for enclosed spaces), plenum (fire-resistant for air ducts), riser (vertical shafts), and armored (steel layer for harsh environments), .
- o Connectors: Terminate both ends of the patch cord. Common types include LC (compact, duplex), SC (push-pull), FC (screw-on), ST (twist-lock), MPO/MTP (multi-fiber), and specialized types like Uniboot LC or E2000 . Connector quality and polishing affect signal loss and performance. Patch cords can be simplex (single fiber, one-way transmission) or duplex (two fibers, bi-directional communication), depending on network requirements .
