Internal components such as circuit breakers, terminals, cable glands, and visual indicators carry additional premiums. Specialized features like thermo-resistant glass windows, anti-loosening fasteners, and Ex db IIC Gb-certified cable glands increase the price .

Installation Considerations

Installation by certified hazardous-area electricians adds 25-40% labor premium over standard electrical work due to the need for precise torque, proper cable gland selection, and verification of intrinsic safety barriers .

Lead Times

Standard models may be in stock, but custom-built ATEX-certified panels can have lead times of 6-16 weeks, depending on size, material, and supplier capacity .
