Factors Affecting Cost

1. **Type and Capacity of FDB** Fiber distribution boxes come in various configurations, supporting 8 to 96 fiber ports or more. Higher port counts and modular designs increase the cost due to additional splice trays, adapters, and cable management features. For standard FTTH deployments, mid-range ABS+PC enclosures are commonly used, balancing durability and cost. 2. **Material and Environmental Protection** Outdoor FDBs require high-impact ABS+PC or SMC materials with IP65-IP68 ratings to resist dust, water, and UV exposure. Indoor boxes can use lighter ABS materials. Outdoor-rated boxes are more expensive due to enhanced durability and weatherproofing. 3. **Labor and Installation Complexity** Installation costs vary based on location, mounting type (wall, pole, or cabinet), and network complexity. Skilled technicians are required for proper splicing, termination, and routing of fibers. Labor can significantly affect the total cost, especially for outdoor or high-density deployments. 4. **Additional Features** Features such as fusion splice trays, bend-radius protection, slack storage, and modular adapters improve performance and maintenance but add to the cost. Surge protection or monitoring ports are optional and increase the price further.

- o Indoor, small-capacity FDB (8-24 ports): \$100-\$200 per unit
 - o Outdoor, medium-capacity FDB (24-48 ports, IP65-IP66): \$200-\$350 per unit
 - o High-capacity or rugged outdoor FDB (48-96 ports, IP66-IP68, modular): \$350-\$500+ per unit
