Factors Affecting Price

o Type of Firestop Material

- o Proper sequencing, such as installing backing plates, arranging firestop packs, and sealing gaps to less than 1 cm², is critical for compliance .

- o Large or high-density cable trays: \$120-\$200 per linear foot, especially if mineral wool and multiple firestop layers are required.
