Handover items for relay protection include documentation, test results, functional verification, and certification to ensure reliable operation of protective relays and associated equipment.

Documentation and Records

- o Operation & Maintenance Manuals: Complete O&M manuals for all relays, including wiring diagrams, settings, and configuration details .
- o Relay Settings and Coordination Sheets: Detailed settings for overcurrent, distance, differential, and directional relays, including coordination with upstream and downstream devices .
- o Test Reports: Factory acceptance test (FAT) and site acceptance test (SAT) reports, including insulation resistance, contact resistance, and partial discharge measurements .
- o Certificates: Calibration certificates for instrument transformers and relays, and compliance certificates with IEC/IEEE standards .

Equipment and Functional Checks

- o Visual Inspection: Check for physical damage, correct installation, and proper labeling of relays and associated wiring .
- o Relay Functional Tests: Verify correct operation of trip, close, indication, and alarm circuits for all relays .
- o Protection Coordination Verification: Ensure relays operate selectively and discriminate between fault and normal conditions .
- o Safety Interlocks: Confirm interlocks and fail-safe mechanisms are functional to prevent unsafe operations .

Electrical Measurements

- o Insulation Resistance and High-Voltage Withstand Tests: Confirm insulation integrity of relay circuits and associated switchgear .
- o Contact Resistance and Continuity Checks: Ensure reliable operation of relay contacts and trip circuits .
- o Partial Discharge Testing: Detect early insulation defects in high-voltage equipment connected to relays .

Certification and Handover

- o Final Handover Certificate: Document that all relay protection systems have been tested, verified, and meet design and safety standards .
- o Training and Operational Handover: Provide training to operating personnel on relay operation, alarm interpretation, and emergency procedures . These handover items ensure that the relay protection system is fully functional, reliable, and compliant with standards, minimizing the risk of equipment damage or system

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outages. Proper documentation and verification also facilitate future maintenance and troubleshooting.
