



Requirements for burying electrical distribution boxes

300.5 provides the minimum cover requirements and is the table used to determine the required cover for a given wiring method and location. Proper application of the provisions in NEC 300.5 helps reduce the risk of physical damage to underground wiring. Burying electrical wiring provides power for outdoor amenities like sheds, hot tubs, or landscape lighting while preserving the property's aesthetic appeal. The process requires adherence to specific guidelines and material standards to ensure the long-term safety and functionality of the system. The use of unarmoured cables, such as HO7RN-F rubber flexible cables or unarmoured XLPE cables buried in the ground, is becoming more popular, especially for DC string wiring of photovoltaic (PV) systems and for certain interconnections in electric vehicle (EV) charging installations. The 2020 edition of the National Fire Protection Association NFPA 70 National Electrical Code is hereby adopted as the minimum requirements for the design, installation, alteration, or repair of electric wires and wiring apparatus and other appliances used or to be. This reference sheet is intended to provide general guidance on common minimum best practices for installing underground residential electrical services. Requirements may vary by jurisdiction.
