ST connectors shall be field installable in one mod-ule space. The fibers shall terminate in 2.5mm ferrules and have typical insertion loss of 0.15dB (multimode) or 0.20dB (singlemode) per connector.

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ST connectors are available for single mode UPC with yellow boots, APC with green boots and multimode PC with black or red boots suitable for either

Ferrule Diameter FC, SC, ST fiber connectors are 2.5mm Ferrule Diameter, on the other hand, LC, MU, E2000 are 1.25mm Ferrule Diameter as shown below.

The diameter of the ferrule and sleeve it uses is 1.25mm, which is half of the size used by ordinary SC, FC, etc. It can increase the density of optical fiber connectors in the optical fiber

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
