3. Polish Type:

- o UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): Standard polish with low insertion loss, suitable for most applications.
- o APC (Angled Physical Contact): Provides lower return loss, ideal for sensitive applications like FTTx, PON, and WDM. APC connectors are usually green and more expensive than UPC. Never mix APC and UPC in the same link.

4. Simplex vs Duplex:

- o Simplex: Single fiber, used for bi-directional BIDI modules.

- o Duplex: Two fibers side-by-side, standard for most optical modules.

5. Jacket Type:

- o PVC: Basic indoor use, cost-effective.

- o LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen): Fire-resistant, emits minimal smoke, suitable for high-safety areas.

- o OFNP/Plenum: Fire-rated for air ducts.

- o Armored: Extra protection for harsh environments.

6. Length and Handling: Select a length that fits the distance between devices without excess slack. Consider bend-insensitive fibers (G.657A1/A2) for tight spaces or FTTH applications.

7. Quality and Supplier: Use trusted suppliers to avoid poor ferrules or inconsistent performance. High-quality cords ensure low insertion loss, durability, and reliability over thousands of mating cycles.

Practical Tips

- o Stick to one connector type per zone to simplify upgrades and maintenance.

- o Color-code connectors (blue for UPC, green for APC) to prevent mismatches.

- o For future-proofing, choose OM3/OM4 multimode or single-mode fibers depending on expected network speeds.

- o Keep spare patch cords for testing and quick replacements. By carefully considering connector type, fiber mode, polish, jacket, and length, you can ensure optimal performance, compatibility, and longevity for your
