

Senegal Home Electrical Distribution Box Model and Dimensions

Standard home electrical distribution boxes in Senegal typically measure 22 x 58 cm for protected feeder cut-off units, with variations depending on the number of circuits and installation type.

Typical Dimensions and Specifications

In Senegal, residential distribution boxes designed for collective housing often feature a glass fibre reinforced polyester enclosure measuring 22 x 58 cm, accommodating 80 A fuses for three-phase electrical distribution . These boxes provide high mechanical resistance (IK10), corrosion and UV protection, and double insulation for operator safety . The internal grill allows connections for 35 to 240 mm² network cables and supports 2 to 4 network bypasses of up to 35 mm² .

General Electrical Box Sizes

For smaller residential applications, standard electrical boxes follow common international sizing conventions:

- o Single-gang boxes: approximately 2? x 3? x 3.5?, suitable for one switch or outlet .
- o Multi-gang boxes: larger boxes to accommodate multiple switches or outlets, with depth often ranging from 3.5? to 4.5? to ensure sufficient wire fill .
- o Junction boxes: typically 4? x 4? or larger, with multiple depth options to allow safe splicing and future access . These dimensions are important to ensure compliance with wiring standards, prevent overcrowding, and allow safe installation of devices and covers .

Material and Safety Considerations

Distribution boxes in Senegal are generally made from insulating, corrosion-resistant materials such as glass fibre reinforced polyester, providing protection against chemicals, UV, and heat . They are designed to meet mechanical and electrical safety standards, including proper insulation and secure mounting for fuses and busbars .

Practical Tips

- o Select box size based on the number of circuits and future expansion needs.
- o Ensure depth and internal volume are sufficient for wire splicing and device installation.
- o Check local electrical codes for minimum box volume and safety requirements.
