

Sequence of power off the home s electrical distribution box

To safely power off household electrical distribution boxes, always turn off branch circuits first, then the main breaker, and verify de-energization before touching any wiring.

Step-by-Step Power-Off Procedure

- o **Turn Off Individual Branch Circuits** Begin by switching off all branch circuit breakers in your main panel. This isolates individual rooms or appliances and reduces the load on the main breaker, minimizing the risk of arcing or electrical shock when the main power is turned off .
- o **Switch Off the Main Breaker** After all branch circuits are off, flip the main circuit breaker to the OFF position. This disconnects the house wiring from the incoming service lines, effectively cutting power to the entire home . Note that the wires between the meter and the main breaker remain live, so avoid contact.
- o **Verify De-Energization** Use a non-contact voltage tester to confirm that the circuits are de-energized before performing any work. Ensure the area is dry and consider wearing insulated gloves and safety glasses for added protection .
- o **Optional: Meter or External Disconnect** In some homes, an external disconnect switch or the meter socket can serve as an additional shutoff point. Only a licensed electrician or utility provider should operate these, as they carry high voltage and pose serious hazards .

Safety Precautions

- o Never touch exposed wires or terminals inside the panel.
- o Ensure all appliances are unplugged before shutting off power to prevent damage.
- o Disconnect control circuits before de-energizing main power circuits in larger distribution setups .
- o Always follow the principle: low-voltage circuits off before high-voltage circuits, and control circuits before main circuits .
