- o IP Ratings and Physical Safety: Panels often have IP30 or higher ratings to protect against dust and splashes,

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with secure terminals to prevent sparking .

- o **Check Connections:** Confirm that all wires and terminals are properly installed and free from insulation interference .

- o **Emergency Systems:** Ensure automatic transfer switches (ATS) are functional to switch to backup power if the main supply fails .
