

Shortest Length of Single-Mode Fiber Optic Module

OM1 Fiber supports 1 Gigabit Ethernet to 275 meters and can support 10 Gigabit Ethernet up to 33 meters. An SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) module transmits data over fiber using specific wavelengths and power levels, which directly influence how far the signal can travel before degradation occurs. This is why two modules with the same form factor can have dramatically different ranges--some limited. Anyone know if that's doable, based on the equipment (switches) that support single-mode? A lot of N-Trons I'm familiar with require a min operating distance of 2 km but wondering if there are others out there that support short runs? Typically any optic (sfp) that is rated for 10km will work for. is there any minimum distance required when using cisco's SFP-10G-LR (smf) to prevent any damage on the receiving SFP+ module? According to what I found in the web there is no minimum distance for IEEE 802.3ae! It can be used even for two meter connections. Can anyone confirm seeing these.
