Steel is preferred for industrial environments, while plastic is suitable for indoor residential use . **Additional Modules:** Modern distribution boxes may include time relays, smart home modules, or monitoring devices to enhance efficiency and control . **Safety Accessories:** In special environments, such as flammable or explosive areas, explosion-proof distribution boxes and additional protective measures should be installed according to relevant standards .

Installation Considerations

- o Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and easily accessible location, typically 1.5-1.8 meters above the ground .
 - o Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed properly to prevent dust or moisture ingress .
 - o Perform insulation, loop impedance, and functional tests before powering on .
 - o Label all circuits clearly and maintain documentation for future inspections or upgrades .
