



Space reserved for opening doors of electrical distribution boxes at construction sites

Preview

Front clearance: There should be a minimum of 3 feet of clearance at the front of all electrical equipment, including panelboards, switches, breakers, starters, transformers, etc. Note that all panel doors and access doors must be able to open a minimum of 90 degrees. Spaces around electrical equipment (width, depth, and height) consist of working space for worker protection [Sec. Dedicated space: The space equal to the width and depth of electrical equipment in addition to the space extending. These rules would apply to electrical equipment such as service equipment, panelboards and load centers, motor control centers (MCC), motor starters, motor drives (VFD), disconnects, switchboards and switchgear as well as the front of dry type transformers. Important Working space required here must not be used for storage. Working space around electrical enclosures or equipment must be adequate for conducting all anticipated maintenance and

A minimum working space 30 inches wide must be provided in front of electrical equipment rated at 600 V or less and is likely to require servicing while energized.

In existing buildings, floor finishes in electrical closets must be consistent with the building's other similar rooms' floor finishes. Floors and curbs in electrical rooms where dielectric liquids are used shall be
