Household lighting distribution boxes are designed to safely manage electrical circuits for lighting, with specifications varying by number of circuits, wire size, and installation type.

Key Specifications

Dimensions and Capacity: For small lighting circuits with incoming wire sizes under 10 mm² and fewer than 20 switches, the box width should be the sum of switch widths plus 20 mm on each side, height should be switch height plus 40 mm, and depth should be maximum switch depth plus 10 mm. For more than 20 switches, two rows are recommended, with width increased by 40 mm while height and depth follow the same formula . **Materials:** Distribution boxes are commonly made from plastic, Zintec steel, or anodized aluminum. Plastic boxes are lightweight and suitable for residential use, while steel and aluminum provide higher durability and protection against mechanical damage . **Safety Features:** Boxes include circuit breakers, fuses, bus bars, and grounding bars to prevent overloads and short circuits. V0-rated molded components and clearly labeled terminals enhance safety and compliance with wiring regulations . **Mounting Types:** Boxes can be flush-mounted (inside walls) or surface-mounted (on wall surfaces). Some models include snap-fit mounting clips, machine screws, and brackets for flexible installation .
