

Standard Configuration of Household Electrical Distribution Boxes in CÔte d'Ivoire

Household electrical distribution boxes in Cote d'Ivoire are designed to manage 230V, 50Hz circuits, with dimensions and configurations based on the number of switches and wire sizes.

Electrical Standards in Cote d'Ivoire

Cote d'Ivoire uses a mains voltage of 230 volts and a frequency of 50 Hz, following the French standard. The common plug types are Type C and Type E, which are compatible with Type F plugs as well . These standards influence the design of household distribution boxes, ensuring compatibility with local appliances and safety requirements.

Distribution Box Specifications

Household distribution boxes serve as centralized points for managing electrical circuits. Key specifications include:

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Wire Size Considerations: For circuits with incoming wires less than 10 mm², boxes for lighting or small power loads can be designed with a single row of switches. For wires greater than 10 mm², special attention is needed for the bending radius and terminal connections .

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Dimensions:

o Width: Sum of switch widths plus 20 mm on each side for fewer than 20 switches; for more than 20 switches, two rows are recommended with 40 mm added to the total width.

o Height: Switch height plus 40 mm.

o Depth: Maximum switch depth plus 10 mm.

o If a separate row is needed for the incoming line switch, add an extra 20 mm on each side for width, while height and depth follow the same calculation .

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Circuit Arrangement: Boxes can accommodate single or double rows of switches depending on the number of circuits. Adequate spacing is required for terminal connections and safe wiring layout.

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Power Distribution Boxes: For higher loads, the same dimensional calculations apply, but additional space must be reserved for larger wires and proper bending radius, ensuring safe and efficient connections .

Installation Considerations

- o Ensure the box is mounted securely and allows easy access for maintenance.
- o Maintain proper spacing between switches and terminals to prevent overheating.
- o Use insulated materials and follow local electrical codes to prevent hazards.
- o Consider future expansion by leaving space for additional circuits if needed.
