

Steps for installing a fiber optic splice box

Installing a fiber optic splice box involves careful cable preparation, secure placement, sealing, grounding, and organized fiber splicing to ensure network reliability.

Step 1: Prepare the Fiber Cable

- o Remove the outer jacket of the optical cable according to the manufacturer's instructions, exposing the loose tubes and strength members. Leave approximately 3 meters of cable for preparation and splicing .
- o Clean and abrade the exposed cable using a cleaning solution and sandpaper (about 150mm) to ensure a smooth surface for sealing .
- o Strip protective coatings from individual fibers as needed, leaving sufficient length for splicing and tray placement .

Step 2: Install the Cable into the Splice Box

- o Select sealing rings that match the cable diameter and place them on the cable.
- o Insert the cable into the designated entry port of the splice closure.
- o Ground the cable shield if metallic layers are present, using the provided grounding hardware .
- o Seal the cable by wrapping self-adhesive tape between the sealing rings to create a watertight barrier.
- o Secure the cable to the base of the closure using hose clamps or other provided hardware, ensuring stability .

Step 3: Organize and Splice Fibers

- o Open the splice closure by loosening the fixing bolts without fully removing them to prevent losing small parts .
- o Place fibers in the splice tray, maintaining the minimum bending radius (typically 10x the fiber diameter for unarmored cables, 15x for armored cables), .
- o Perform splicing (fusion or mechanical) according to standard procedures, securing each splice in the holders provided.
- o Wind excess fiber neatly in the tray to prevent stress or damage .

Step 4: Final Sealing and Closure

- o Check all components are properly seated and fibers are organized.
- o Seal the closure by tightening bolts and ensuring all entry points are watertight.
- o Verify grounding and bonding connections are secure.
- o Label the closure for identification and maintenance purposes .

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Step 5: Testing and Verification

- o Test optical continuity and signal loss using an OTDR or power meter to ensure splices are low-loss and functional.
 - o Document the installation including splice counts, cable routes, and test results for future maintenance .
- Following these steps ensures a reliable, low-loss fiber optic connection and protects the network from environmental damage, mechanical stress, and signal degradation.
