Step 2: Prepare the Wires

- o Cut wires to the required length, allowing enough slack for maintenance but avoiding clutter.
- o Strip insulation from the ends of the wires to expose the conductive core. The stripped length should match the terminal block specifications.
- o For stranded wires, use ferrules to bundle strands together for a secure connection .

Step 3: Connect Wires to Terminal Blocks

- o Loosen screws or clamps on the terminal block.
- o Insert stripped wire ends into the appropriate terminals:
 - o Incoming power or signal wires connect to input terminals.
 - o Outgoing wires connect to devices or circuits.
 - o Ground wires connect to the designated grounding terminal.
 - o Neutral wires in AC systems connect to the neutral terminal .
- o Tighten screws or clamps to secure the wires, ensuring no exposed conductor is left outside the terminal.

Step 4: Organize and Label Connections

- o Number or label each terminal according to the wiring diagram to simplify troubleshooting and maintenance.
- o Use color-coded wires where possible to distinguish between power, neutral, and ground connections .

Step 5: Verify and Test

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- o Double-check all connections against the wiring diagram.
- o Ensure there are no loose wires or potential short circuits.
- o Test the circuit with a multimeter or appropriate testing device before energizing the system .

- o Use modular terminal blocks on DIN rails for easier expansion and maintenance.
- o Maintain proper spacing between terminals to prevent accidental contact.
