Powerline Adapters

Powerline adapters use your home's electrical wiring to transmit internet signals. One adapter connects to a router with internet access, and another adapter plugs into an outlet near the device you want to connect. This method provides a wired-like connection without running Ethernet cables throughout your home .

Wi-Fi Extenders and Mesh Systems

To improve coverage in areas with weak Wi-Fi signals, Wi-Fi extenders or mesh networks can be used. Extenders amplify the existing signal, while mesh systems create a seamless network with multiple nodes, ensuring consistent connectivity across larger spaces without additional cabling .
