Types of Elbows

o Horizontal Elbows

- o Change the direction of the cable tray on the same plane.
- o Common angles include 30°, 45°, and 90°.
- o Used to navigate around walls, columns, or other obstacles without altering elevation .

o Vertical Elbows (Risers)

- o Allow the tray to move upward or downward between different elevations.
- o Can be inside or outside vertical bends depending on whether the tray turns inward or outward relative to the bend .

o Combination or Multi-Angle Elbows

- o Used when a change in both horizontal and vertical planes is required simultaneously.

- o Trough-type trays and elbows are typically made from steel (galvanized or stainless), aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic, depending on environmental conditions and load requirements .
- o All elbows should maintain the minimum bend radius for cables to prevent damage and ensure compliance with standards like NEC Article 392 .
- o Fittings are designed to match the width and depth of the straight tray sections to ensure smooth cable transitions .

Installation Notes

- o Elbows are connected to straight sections using splice plates, bolts, and nuts to maintain structural integrity .
- o Covers may be added to protect cables from dust, debris, or mechanical damage, especially in solid-bottom trough trays .
- o Proper support, such as wall brackets or trapeze hangers, should be installed near elbows to prevent sagging and maintain alignment .
