

Wall-mounted dimensions of distribution boxes

Typical wall-mounted distribution boxes range from 200x200x120 mm up to 800x600x300 mm, with specific models like medium distribution fiber boxes measuring 250x280x100 mm.

Standard Wall-Mount Enclosure Sizes

Wall-mounted electrical enclosures are available in a variety of standardized size families, allowing flexibility in height, width, and depth without changing the product series. Typical dimensions for general-purpose wall-mounted enclosures range from 200x200x120 mm to 800x600x300 mm, with many intermediate sizes available to accommodate different internal layouts, cable entry space, and future expansion . These dimensions usually refer to external measurements, while internal usable space is slightly smaller due to wall thickness, gaskets, and hardware .

Electrical Box Types and Dimensions

- o Single-gang boxes: Common for one switch or outlet, typically around 2? x 3? x 3.5? (50x75x90 mm), with depth options from 1.5? to 3.5? to accommodate wire count .
- o Junction boxes: Often 4? x 4? (100x100 mm) with multiple depth options, providing sufficient clearance for splicing and cover installation .
- o Multi-gang boxes: Allow multiple switches or outlets in one location, with width increasing proportionally to the number of gangs .

Fiber Distribution Wall Boxes

For fiber optic applications, medium distribution wall boxes are designed for wall mounting and fiber distribution. A typical example has dimensions of width 250 mm x height 280 mm x depth 100 mm, supporting up to 168 fiber splices and multiple customer drop cables. These boxes often include top and bottom cable entry ports, splice trays, and an IP55 rating for indoor or outdoor use .

Considerations for Choosing Dimensions

When selecting a wall-mounted distribution box, consider:

- o Internal volume: Ensure enough space for wiring, splices, and future expansion .
- o Cable entry and bend radius: Adequate space for routing cables without stress .
- o Protection rating: IP55 or higher for outdoor or washdown environments .
- o Material and weight: Plastic, FRP, or metal depending on load and environmental conditions .
