Cantilever Brackets

Cantilever brackets extend from a wall or structural support to hold cable trays without additional vertical supports. They are useful for installations where space is limited or where trays need to extend over equipment or obstacles. Cantilever hangers are designed to handle the weight of the tray and cables while minimizing structural interference .

Specialized Hangers

Other specialized hangers include center suspensions, which support trays at mid-span for long runs, and adjustable clamps or rods for flexible positioning. These hangers are often used in industrial or commercial installations where cable trays must navigate complex layouts or changes in direction .

Key Considerations

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When selecting a cable tray hanger, factors such as load capacity, material finish (e.g., galvanized for corrosion resistance), spacing between supports, and compatibility with the tray type (ladder, ventilated, or solid-bottom) are critical to ensure safety and durability . Proper installation prevents sagging, structural stress, and potential hazards in the cable system.
