- o Main Switch/Isolator: Controls the entire power supply to the box.
- o Earth and Neutral Bars: Provide grounding and complete the electrical circuit.
- o DIN Rails and Cable Entry Points: Facilitate neat installation and modular expansion .

- o Load Requirements: Match wiring method to the expected electrical load.
- o Environment: Indoor, outdoor, or industrial conditions affect insulation and protection ratings.
- o Safety Compliance: Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) and use certified components.
- o Future Expansion: Modular designs and extra capacity allow for easy upgrades .
