- o Addressing and Configuration: DIP switches and rotary DIP switches are used in PLCs and SCADA systems to set node addresses or configure system parameters, ensuring proper communication and control within automation networks .

- o Toggle Switches: Simple on/off control for basic operations .
- o Push-Button Switches: Momentary or maintained contact for starting, stopping, or emergency functions .
- o Selector Switches: Rotary or key-operated switches for selecting operational modes .
- o Emergency Stop (E-Stop) Buttons: Large, easily accessible buttons for immediate shutdown .
- o Mushroom Head Push Buttons: Latching push-buttons for emergency or lockout functions .
- o Key Switches: Require a key to operate, providing controlled access .
- o Limit, Pressure, Level, and Flow Switches: Detect physical conditions and provide digital signals to PLCs or

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control systems .
