- o Perforated or Ventilated Troughs: Feature small holes in the bottom to allow limited airflow, helping with heat dissipation while still maintaining cable support .
- o Side Rails: Continuous side rails enhance structural integrity and prevent cables from falling out.
- o Materials: Commonly made from galvanized steel, aluminum, or FRP, depending on environmental exposure and load requirements .

Applications

Tray-type cable trays are widely used in industrial, commercial, and hazardous locations where cable protection is critical. They are often selected for:

- o Single conductor cables and Type MV cables, which are not permitted in solid-bottom trays in certain NEC applications .
- o Class II, Division 2 hazardous locations, where dust or flammable particles are present .
- o Environments requiring limited cable access, such as secure or sensitive installations .

- o Moderate ventilation in perforated designs helps prevent overheating.
- o Enhanced security for cables in sensitive or hazardous areas.
