The rated current indicates the maximum continuous current the box can safely handle, while the short-circuit capacity specifies the maximum fault current the box and its components can withstand without damage. These ratings are essential for selecting a box that matches the load requirements and ensures safety during electrical faults .

Enclosure Protection

Specifications such as IP (Ingress Protection) or NEMA ratings indicate the box's resistance to dust, water, UV exposure, and impact. For outdoor or harsh environments, higher ratings (e.g., IP65 or NEMA 4) are required to prevent corrosion and ensure long-term reliability . Material type and corrosion resistance are also part of the specification.

Internal Layout

The internal layout includes busbar type, neutral and earth bar arrangement, DIN rail space, and cable entry points. Proper layout ensures safe and organized wiring, reduces electrical faults, and allows for easier
